

**Peruvian delegation will participate in the 7th. International Carbon Fair-  
Carbon Expo 2010 in Cologne**

For seventh consecutive year will be held from 26 to May 28 this year, the 7th. International Fair of Carbon Market - CARBON EXPO 2010, being hosted this time by the city of Cologne, Alemania. This year, the organizers are the World Bank, the International Emissions Trading (IETA) and the Cologne Fair (Koelnmesse).

Last year, 276 companies from over 83 countries and 3,000 visitors from over 111 countries met to discuss anything that covers carbon market, from its environmental impact to its importance within the economy world. The numbers give an idea of the importance that have acquired carbon markets as an environmental tool, but also the economic importance of these instruments as a mean to face climate change through technology transfer and mobilization of financial flows.

The Peruvian delegation, Seventh Mission for Environmental Investment Promotion, will consist of representatives of FONAM addition, representatives of companies that are developing projects which are applying for Clean Development Mechanism under the Kyoto Protocol.

The Seventh Mission for Environmental Investment Promotion is promoted and organized by the National Environment Fund - FONAM, will have a post financed by the World Bank and will be attending the fair with a portfolio of around 190 projects in energy and forest sectors, which represent new investment to the country for more than U.S.\$ 11,700 million.
